ATHLETIC DIRECTOR MEETING
Summary of Meeting January 2009 ***

Brand Athletics and Nike Representative presented on Nike team uniforms. Big 9 schools are being offered an agreement between Nike and the school for game-day uniforms.

Pending protest of Boys Basketball of West Valley at Eisenhower from last Saturday. Kuntz is gathering information on the official protest from the involved parties. Kuntz will get CBBN Principals to rule on the case.

League Re-alignment committee will meet next week and be headed by Darcy Weisner of Walla Walla.

Cross-Classification meeting held last week in Othello regarding the State football and soccer brackets. League supports the recommendation for a committee to discuss the issue at the State level.

SELF REPORTS

Wenatchee self report of article 18.6.0 and 27.4.0 of a Girl Bowler. The student/athlete scores will be zeroed and Wenatchee will forfeit the 3 contests they initially won (11/13, 11/20 and 12/16). M/S/P to accept the recommendation of the forfeit of contests.

Southridge self report of article 18.10.0 of two male Wrestlers. Each student/athletes individual matches will be forfeited on 12/9 and 1/6 as well as the team points adjusted. Walla Walla awarded team win with point adjustment. M/S/P to accept the report as presented and place the Southridge coach and wrestling program on probation for one calendar year from Jan. 6, 2009 to Jan. 6, 2010.

Kennewick self report of article 18.3.0 of C team Girl Basketball player. M/S/P for the team to forfeit the contest on 12/18/08 and place the coach on probation for one calendar year from Dec. 19, 2008 to Dec. 19, 2009.

Varsity start times should be 3:30 for field events and running at 4 PM (pending facilities and workers)

Golf

Inland Empire and Ike boys POD are both tentatively set for April 27, so work is being done to revise.

Football

Week 9 sub-varsity games will be how the Varsity places & their opponent, with frosh on Thursday/Friday same site and JV on Monday opposite site. For week 10, league will predetermine games with some schools opting-out.

M/S/F to start Varsity games at 7 PM due to concerns about transportation issues, out of school time and cost of subs as well as time for frosh double-headers. May consider in the future for winter sports with school-night games and poor road conditions.

Volleyball

M/S/P for the SOP's under two-way tie to have a tiebreaker for 1st or 8th place only, and the winner of the regular season match between the two will host the tiebreaker match. M/S/P to use head to head for all other ties (places 2-7) for seeding.
