DSV FILM EXCHANGE

Rick Anderson from DSV came to present their film exchange proposal to the league. DSV Essential Edition 5.0 will enable coaches to upload, download and cut their film on-line with the server in Los Angeles. Schools must use the DSV Essential to capture the video and the software goes on one machine. The software and their file format will enable the schools to share. Schools can use whatever software they want to edit after the capture. Also part of the package is free website for the football team. **M/S/P to have the league use DSV for football film exchange, pending a contract showing all schools would be trained by June 1 and that a written contract would be in place stating it was a one time only fee.**

M/S/P the league would purchase the software and invoice each school.
